



The British Safety Industry Federation (BSiF) the recognised Trade Body for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in the UK, bring this information to your immediate attention.

The Office for Product Safety and Standards along with our Primary Authority Partners, Hertfordshire Trading Standards are reminding all those involved in the supply chain that since April 2018 motorcycle protective clothing has been included under PPE Regulation 2016/425 and the placing of product on the EU market requires that it complies with the Regulation.

“All Personal Protective Equipment requires a CE mark which is the manufacturer’s statement the product complies with relevant EU legislation. A CE mark on motorcycle protective clothing means the product complies with PPE requirements and the public should look for that particular mark.”
